## RESOLUTION NO. 39–2018

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE ROUTE CHANGES OF TRANSIT SERVICE PROVIDED BY CITYLINK

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (City) owns and operates CityLink; and

WHEREAS, the City receives grant funding through Federal Transportation Administration (FTA), as authorized by the Congress of the United States of America and Texas Department of Transportation (TXDOT) operating costs; and

WHEREAS, the City also supports CityLink's operating costs through a General Fund subsidy; and

WHEREAS, CityLink operates its schedules and routes based on guidance from City Council; and

WHEREAS, Bus Routes have been relatively unchanged for over ten (10) years while many changes to key needs and interest locations have occurred in the city; and

WHEREAS, CityLink has conducted surveys, route modeling and worked with a Stakeholder Task Force to develop new routes; and

WHEREAS, the City held public hearings on the proposed route changes November 8th and 14th, 2017.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

- Part 1. That CityLink is authorized to make changes to its Fixed Route Bus System as shown in Attachment A.
- Part 2. That the new routes take effect June 4, 2018.






