

RESOLUTION NO. 49-2018

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS
AUTHORIZING FUNDING FOR THE REGIONAL VICTIM CRISIS CENTER DURING
FISCAL YEARS 2017-2018**

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene has provided funding to the Regional Victim Crisis Center, a non-profit corporation, for more than 40 years; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Victim Crisis Center provides Abilene victims of violent crime assistance, including counseling and education; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Victim Crisis Center is the primary referral for all Abilene victims of child abuse.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Part 1: The City Council finds that the funding to the Regional Victim Crisis Center will serve a predominantly public purpose of the City, that the City will retain sufficient control to ensure the public purpose is carried out, and the City will receive a return benefit.

Part 2: The City Council approves the funding for the Regional Victim Crisis Center.

Part 3: The City Manager is authorized to execute the necessary transaction(s) for the funding.

Part 4. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after passage.
