

RESOLUTION NO. 56-2018

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A ROADWAY PARTICIPATION INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS AND WYLIE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, WISD is developing its East Elementary school campus on Colony Hill Road and Maple Street in Abilene, Texas; and,

WHEREAS, the City's Land Development Code, Section 3.2.2.5 provides that a Developer shall make improvements to substandard perimeter roads; and,

WHEREAS, the CITY is required to participate in the costs of perimeter roads in excess of the developer's fair share obligations and where such costs are not borne by another public entity; and,

WHEREAS, Wylie Independent School District (WISD) and the City of Abilene, Texas (CITY) desire to work together to construct roadways in order to minimize costs and minimize the inconvenience to the public that results from road construction; and,

WHEREAS, WISD will contract with a third party Contractor to make the improvement to the portion of Colony Hill Road and to the portion of Maple Street, and,

WHEREAS, WISD may also contract with the same third party Contractor to make improvements to other portions of Colony Hill Road and/or Maple Street, which are not part of the Project referred to in this Interlocal Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: The City Manager is authorized to execute a Roadway Participation Interlocal Agreement between the City of Abilene, Texas and Wylie Independent School District.
