

RESOLUTION NO. 57-2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AWARDING BID FOR THE SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM INTERCEPTOR LINE INSPECTION AND CLEANING PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (City) owns and operates a sanitary sewer collection system consisting of over 675 miles of buried sewer main piping; and

WHEREAS, in June 2013 the City entered into the Sanitary Sewer Overflow Agreement with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (Agreement), and Provision 6 of the Agreement requires that the City perform the second phase of cleaning and inspection of large sewer mains; and

WHEREAS, the Water Utilities Department does not have the proper equipment or staff experience to clean large sewer interceptors, and typically hires qualified contractors to perform that work; and

WHEREAS, Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd, Inc. (eHT) was hired to assist the City in developing the interceptor cleaning and inspection project, prepare contract documents and specifications, supervise the Project, and compile the data and report the results to City staff; and

WHEREAS, the AIMS Companies (AIMS) submitted the lowest qualifying bid in the amount of \$91,685.00 for the Sanitary Sewer System Interceptor Line Inspection and Cleaning Project, and eHT has evaluated the low bid for conformity with the advertisement for bids and checked the references of the apparent low bidder and does recommend awarding the bid to AIMS Companies; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the City Manager is authorized to execute a construction contract with the AIMS Companies for the Sanitary Sewer System Interceptor Line Inspection and Cleaning Project in the amount of \$91,685.00.
