

RESOLUTION NO. 92-2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AWARDING THE BID TO THE J.S. HAREN COMPANY FOR THE NORTHEAST WATER TREATMENT PLANT PRISON PUMP MODIFICATIONS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (City) Northeast Water Treatment Plant utilizes two designated pumps (Prison Pumps) to supply treated water to the area located within the Abilene City limits and being east of Lake Fort Phantom Hill and including the Middleton and Robertson prison units of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice; and

WHEREAS, the prison pumps have been in almost continuous operation over many years and one of those pumps is worn out and in need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, Jacob and Martin LLC (JM) was hired to assist the City in evaluating the condition of the pump and piping and then prepare plans and contract documents, and provide bidding assistance, project supervision (not RPR), and project administration for the Northeast Water Treatment Plant Prison Pump Modifications Project; and

WHEREAS, the J.S. Haren Company (Haren) submitted the lowest qualifying bid in the amount of \$247,000.00 for the Northeast Water Treatment Plant Prison Pump Modifications Project, and JM has evaluated the low bid for conformity with the advertisement for bids and checked the references of the apparent low bidder and does recommend awarding the bid to Haren; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the City Manager is authorized to execute a construction contract with the J.S. Haren Company for the Northeast Water Treatment Plant Prison Pump Modifications Project in the amount of \$247,000.00.
