

**RESOLUTION NO. 93-2018**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AWARDING THE BID TO STARKS CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC. FOR THE 24 INCH SEWER LINE ABANDONMENT PROJECT.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Abilene (City) owns and operates a sanitary sewer collection system for collecting and transporting the City's municipal wastewater flows to the Hamby Water Reclamation Facility in accordance with the TPDES permit ID# 0010334004; and

**WHEREAS**, there exists a section of 24" vitrified clay sewer piping that is in poor condition, and because of operational improvements made over time that large diameter section is no longer able to effectively transport the small, localized sewer flows of that area and therefore it is in need of being replaced and then abandoned in place; and

**WHEREAS**, Jacob and Martin LLC (JM) was hired to assist the City in evaluating the condition of the sewer system in the vicinity of Madison Avenue and Hillcrest Drive and then prepare plans and contract documents, and provide bidding assistance, project supervision (not RPR), and project administration for the 24" Sewer Line Abandonment Project; and

**WHEREAS**, Starks Construction Company, Inc. (Starks) submitted the lowest qualifying bid in the amount of \$797,185.00 for the 24" Sewer Line Abandonment Project, and JM has evaluated the low bid for conformity with the advertisement for bids and checked the references of the apparent low bidder and does recommend awarding the bid to Starks; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:**

That the City Manager is authorized to execute a construction contract with Starks Construction Company, Inc. for the 24" Sewer Line Abandonment Project in the amount of \$797,185.00.


