

RESOLUTION NO. 114-2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS DONATING UNUSED ADVERTISING DISPLAY SPACE TO ABILENE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE FOR LOCAL BUSINESS PROMOTION

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (City) owns and operates Abilene Regional Airport (Airport); and

WHEREAS, the Airport has two rotating doors at the upper level entrance with two display cases on each door; and

WHEREAS, the Airport has tried unsuccessfully to lease the display spaces for advertising; and

WHEREAS, the Airport is a member of Abilene Chamber of Commerce (Chamber); and

WHEREAS, the Airport seeks to utilize the display spaces for local business promotion through the Chamber; and

WHEREAS, the Airport seeks to donate the space to the Chamber for stated local business promotion use at no cost to the Chamber; and

WHEREAS, the use of the spaces will continue under a use agreement until the Airport gains a user/advertiser for an advertising fee or the Airport determines another use for the spaces, wherein the agreement with the Chamber will terminate according to the terms of the agreement; and

WHEREAS, the donation of the spaces: (1) will serve a predominantly public purpose of the City by promoting local businesses that contribute to the economy of the City; (2) the City will retain sufficient control to ensure the public purpose is carried out; and (3) the City will receive a return benefit of showing how the spaces can be utilized for future paid advertising.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

- Part 1.** That the display spaces in the Airport Terminal rotating doors be donated to Abilene Chamber of Commerce per the terms of the Use Agreement.
- Part 2.** That this donated space be used by the Chamber solely for the purpose of promoting local businesses.
- Part 3.** That the City Council finds that donation of the spaces will serve a predominately public purpose of the City.
- Part 4.** That the City will retain sufficient control to ensure the public purpose is carried out, and the City will receive a return benefit.
- Part 5.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after passage.
