

**RESOLUTION NO. 115-2018**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS ACCEPTING THE FINAL REPORT OF THE JOINT LAND USE STUDY FOR DYESS AIR FORCE BASE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Abilene (City) recognizes the critical role Dyess Air Force Base plays in the defense of the United States and the economy of this region; and

**WHEREAS**, Dyess AFB has identified through an Air Installation Compatibility Use Zone study (2015) encroachment and other concerns around the base; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Abilene, City of Tye, Taylor County, View/Caps Area Residents and Dyess Staff jointly partnered to conduct a Joint Land Use Study (JLUS) per the guidelines of the Department of Defense; and

**WHEREAS**, an extensive study of factors related to the influences Dyess and the communities have on each other resulted in recommendations found in the JLUS Final Report; and

**WHEREAS**, throughout the course of the JLUS, the Policy and Technical Committees composed of each entities' appointed members contributed data and insight to the Background and Finals Reports; and

**WHEREAS**, the Policy and Technical Committees approved the JLUS Final Report in February 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, the JLUS Final Report was approved by City of Tye Council May 29, 2018 and Taylor County Commissioners July 11, 2018.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:**

1. That the Dyess Air Force Base Joint Land Use Study Final Report is approved and adopted.
2. That the Implementation Committee is a necessary part of assuring the Report's recommendations are addressed in a way that balances the interests of Dyess and the communities.
