

RESOLUTION NO. 134-2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH ENPROTEC/HIBBS & TODD, INC. FOR THE BUCK CREEK SCREW PUMP STATION IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (City) owns and operates a sanitary sewer collection system for collecting and transporting the City's municipal wastewater flows to the Hamby Water Reclamation Facility (HWRF) in accordance with the TPDES permit ID# 0010334004; and

WHEREAS, Abilene's municipal wastewater flows by gravity to the Buck Creek Pump Station (BCPS) where it is collected and pumped uphill to the HWRF; and

WHEREAS, the Buck Creek Screw Pump Station is a component of the BCPS and is utilized to lift sewage from a deep sewer outfall pipe up to the processing level of the BCPS; and

WHEREAS, on May 29, 2017 one of the two screw pumps experienced catastrophic failure and City staff subsequently initiated two contracts with Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd, Inc. (EHT) totaling \$69,000.00, one contract to evaluate the pump failure and provide options for restoring the lost pump capacity, and then a second contract for designing a very basic submerged pump installation to replace the failed screw pump; and

WHEREAS, staff is recommending that the Abilene City Council authorize a professional services contract with Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd, Inc. for the preparation of plans and contract documents for an expanded design scope-of-services, and providing for bidding assistance, project supervision, a part-time RPR, and project administration for the Buck Creek Screw Pump Station Improvements Project in an amount not to exceed \$85,000.00; and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the City Manager is authorized to execute a professional services contract with Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$85,000.00 for the Buck Creek Screw Pump Station Improvements Project.
