

RESOLUTION NO. 138-2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AWARDING THE BID TO DOWTECH SPECIALTY CONTRACTORS, INC. FOR THE NEWTP PRISON JOCKEY PUMP INSTALLATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (City) Northeast Water Treatment Plant utilizes two designated pumps (Prison Pumps) to supply treated water to the area located within the Abilene City limits and being east of Lake Fort Phantom Hill and including the Middleton and Robertson prison units of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice; and

WHEREAS, the prison pumps have been in almost continuous operation over many years in order to meet the high water demands of the prison units; and

WHEREAS, Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd, Inc. (EHT) was hired to assist the City in evaluating the condition of the prison pumping system and to design system improvements to improve capacity and provide redundancy of the prison pumping system; and

WHEREAS, Dowtech Specialty Contractors, Inc. (Dowtech) submitted the lowest qualifying bid in the amount of \$72,778.00 for the NEWTP Prison Jockey Installation Project, and EHT has evaluated the low bid for conformity with the advertisement for bids and checked the references of the apparent low bidder and does recommend awarding the bid to Dowtech; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the City Manager is authorized to execute a construction contract with Dowtech Specialty Contractors, Inc. for the NEWTP Prison Jockey Pump Installation Project in the amount of \$72,778.00.
