

RESOLUTION NO. 157-2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AWARDING THE BID TO CARBONFILT, LLC FOR FILTER MEDIA FOR PRODUCTION OF POTABLE WATER.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (City) Northeast Water Treatment Plant utilizes seven dual media filters in the production of treated potable water in compliance with Texas Commission on Environmental Quality regulations 30 TAC Chapter 290; and

WHEREAS, the water treatment plant operators identified a failure of the filter undrain on Filter #5 which requires the removal of the filter media from that filter, implementing repairs to the filter underdrain, and replacing the filter media with new material; and

WHEREAS, there is also the need to add makeup filter media to the remaining six filters to restore filter beds to the original design depth, and this procurement provides for sufficient media material for replacing media in Filter #5 and for makeup media in the remaining filters; and

WHEREAS, Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd, Inc. (EHT) was hired to assist the City in evaluating the condition of Filter #5 and for securing a contractor to implement the repair to the underdrain and to remove and install the filter media; and

WHEREAS, Carbonfilt LLC (Carbonfilt) submitted the lowest qualifying bid at the combined unit price of \$593.93 per ton for Silica Sand (159.25 per ton) and Filter Anthracite (434.68 per ton), and staff does recommend awarding the bid to Carbonfilt; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the Abilene City Council awards the bid to Carbonfilt, LLC at the combined unit price of \$593.93 per ton for the purchase of Filter Media for Production of Potable Water.
