

RESOLUTION NO. 161-2018

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS
AUTHORIZING THE GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE 2018 JUSTICE ASSISTANCE
GRANT.**

WHEREAS, The Abilene Police Department and the Taylor County Sheriff's Office are jointly applying for the 2018 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG Grant) in an amount of \$43,578; and

WHEREAS, the City and the County agree it is in their best interest to equally split the 2018 JAG Grant if awarded; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires City Council approval of the grant and the application thereof; and

WHEREAS, there are no matching fund requirements;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF ABILENE, TEXAS:**

PART 1: The City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute any grant documents to secure the 2018 Justice Assistance Grant.

PART 2: The City of Abilene will equally distribute the JAG grant, if awarded, with the Taylor County Sheriff's Office.

PART 3: The JAG grant, if awarded, shall be \$43,578.00.
