

RESOLUTION NO. 204-2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AWARDING THE BID TO BONTKE BROTHERS CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR THE N. 6TH STREET WATER LINE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the voters of Abilene approved the 2015 Bond Program Proposition #1 for the rehabilitation of twenty five street segments located throughout the City of Abilene (City) including N. Leggett Drive and continuing east along N. 6th Street to Grape Street, and Butternut Street beginning at S. 1st Street and continuing south to Treadaway Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, City staff and Consulting Engineers evaluated the condition of water utility infrastructure existing beneath the pavement of each of Leggett, N. 6th, and Butternut Streets and determined that it is wise to replace certain water utility infrastructure prior to the street rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, Jacob & Martin, LLC (JM) was hired to assist the City in evaluating the water utility infrastructure of various street sections, providing the City with costs and utility replacement options, and then designing the water line improvements including providing design plans, specifications, and contract documents, bidding assistance and project administration for making the needed improvements; and

WHEREAS, Bontke Brothers Construction Company (Bontke) submitted the lowest qualifying bid for the N. 6th Street Water Line Improvements Project in the amount of \$984,677.50 and the Engineer reviewed the bid proposal, verified references, and recommends awarding the bid to Bontke; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the Abilene City Council awards the bid to Bontke Brothers Construction Company for the N. 6th Street Water Line Improvements Project in the amount of \$984,677.50.
