## **RESOLUTION NO. 139-2020**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH INSITUFORM TECHNOLOGIES, LLC. THROUGH BUYBOARD COOPERATIVE PURCHASING FOR THE 2020 SANITARY SEWER CLEAN AND TV PROJECT.

WHEREAS, on June 19th, 2013 the City of Abilene entered into the Sanitary Sewer Overflow Agreement (Agreement) with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, and Provision 10 of the Agreement requires that Abilene perform the forth phase of cleaning and CCTV inspection of large sewer mains; and

WHEREAS, the City hired Jacob and Martin, LLC. (JM) to assist City staff in acquiring cleaning and CCTV inspection services using a list of high priority sewer collection system mains, and to utilize the resulting inspection data to determine the best methods for a subsequent rehabilitation project; and

WHEREAS, it was determined that the City could obtain the cleaning and CCTV inspection services through BuyBoard Cooperative Purchasing at contract pricing in compliance with Texas Local Government Code Chapter 271, and said pricing is a good value for the City; and

WHEREAS, City staff and JM recommend the contract with Insituform Technologies, LLC for the 2020 Sanitary Sewer Clean and TV Project in the amount of \$279,864.00; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the Abilene City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute the contract with Insituform Technologies, LLC for the 2020 Sanitary Sewer Clean and TV Project in the amount of \$279,864.00.
