

**RESOLUTION NO. 11-2021**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS,  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH  
LUMINARE INC. FOR COVID VACCINE MANAGEMENT SOLUTION SOFTWARE**

**WHEREAS**, the Abilene-Taylor County Public Health District (ATCPHD) is a designated Vaccination Hub to provide the COVID-19 vaccine for our region; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of State Health Services Immunization Unit has awarded ACPHD "one time" funds in the amount of \$64,955 to be used for allowable pandemic vaccination activities; and

**WHEREAS**, an allowable pandemic vaccination activities is vaccine administration documentation and reporting; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is seeking to purchase and implement an electronic tool to automate scheduling, vaccine paperwork, and reporting to ImmTrac2, and this product will provide for the automation of the registration and scheduling process for individuals to receive the COVID-19 vaccination in our region; and


**WHEREAS**, this purchase is necessary to preserve or protect the public health or safety of the municipality's residents caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:**


- PART 1:** That the City Manager is authorized to enter into a 12-month contract with Luminare Inc. for COVID-19 vaccine administration documentation and reporting in the amount of \$90,000.00.
- PART 2:** That this purchase is necessary to preserve and protect the public health or safety of the municipality's residents caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.
- PART 3:** That this Resolution is effective immediately upon adoption.
