

RESOLUTION NO. 31-2021

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A WATER MAIN PARTICIPATION INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS AND WYLIE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, Wylie ISD is developing an Intermediate Campus near the intersection of Oldham Lane (FM 1750) and Hardison Lane in Abilene, TX; and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with City of Abilene Ordinance Section 32-114, when a landowner constructs the extension of a water main, the City may participate in the oversize cost of any water main larger than eight (8) inches in diameter; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the construction of the new campus, WISD is installing a new water main along Oldham Lane, Colony Hill Road, and Hardison Road; and

WHEREAS, WISD's cost to install an eight (8) inch water main along the above-mentioned roads is \$579,577.44; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost to upsize the facilities on Oldham Lane and Colony Hill Road, as the water utility department has determined is necessary to accommodate for future development, is \$266,289.56; and

WHEREAS, Wylie ISD will contract with a third party Contractor for construction of the improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS

PART 1: The City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute a Water Main Participation Interlocal Agreement between the City of Abilene, Texas and Wylie Independent School District.
