

RESOLUTION NO. 54-2021

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS,
AWARDING A CONTRACT TO WILLIS ELECTRIC, CO., ABILENE, TEXAS**

WHEREAS, the traffic signal pole at the intersection of South 14th Street and Clack Street was damaged by an uninsured motorist in a vehicle accident; and,

WHEREAS, the unforeseen damage to the signal pole caused an immediate public safety issue for the City's residents; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene solicited quotes from for repair of the signal pole; and,

WHEREAS, Willis Electric provided the lowest quote for repair in the amount of \$64,400.00 to replace all necessary components to get this signal functioning properly and safely.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:**

PART 1: That the City Council approves this emergency contract in the amount of \$64,400.00 to Willis Electric.

PART 2: That the procurement of emergency repairs to the damaged signal pole is necessary to preserve and protect the public health and safety of the City's residents, and is necessary because of unforeseen damage to public property.


PART 3: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
