

RESOLUTION NO. 63-2021

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT WITH BETTY HARDWICK CENTER FOR THE ADAPTIVE RECREATION BUILDING TO OFFER AN ADULT ADAPTIVE RECREATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene closed the Adaptive Recreation Program in March of 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wanted to explore having an outside organization manage the Adaptive Recreation Program in the Adaptive Recreation Building; and

WHEREAS, Betty Hardwick Center approached the City as an interested organization; and

WHEREAS, the City seeks to enter into a lease agreement with Betty Hardwick Center; and

WHEREAS, the lease agreement is for \$1 annually.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Part 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a lease agreement with Betty Hardwick Center for the Adaptive Recreation building to offer an adult Adaptive Recreation Program.

Part 2: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after passage.
