

RESOLUTION NO. 70-2021

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MEALS ON WHEELS PLUS, INCORPORATED FOR THE DISBURSEMENT OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDS

WHEREAS, as an entitlement City receiving funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Community Development (HUD), the City of Abilene is the recipient of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program funds; and

WHEREAS, the primary objective of the CDBG Program is to improve the environment within the City of Abilene principally for the benefit of low and moderate income citizens, pursuant to the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted the *2020-2024 Consolidated Plan* and *2020-2021 Action Plan* via resolution 199-2020 on October 8, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Meals on Wheels Plus, Incorporated is an organization devoted to serving the frail elderly and younger adults with disabilities that are often in need of meals; and

WHEREAS, Meals on Wheels Plus, Incorporated successfully applied for \$81,000.00 in CDBG funding for the purposes of replacing kitchen air conditioners, exhaust fans, and an ice machine; and

WHEREAS, this request for CDBG funding was included as a recommended project in the *2020-2024 Consolidated Plan* and *2020-2021 Action Plan* adopted by City Council on October 8, 2020.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Manager of the City of Abilene, Texas is hereby authorized to sign said Agreement and all appurtenant documents on behalf of the City.

PART 2: That the financial assistance authorized by the Community Development Block Grant Program referred to above is required to enable the City of Abilene to carry out appropriate community development activities directed toward meeting program objectives.
