

RESOLUTION NO. 78-2021

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS APPROVING PURCHASE OF ECOLANE SCHEDULING SOFTWARE THROUGH THE NATIONAL COOPERATIVE PURCHASING ALLIANCE (NCPA)

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (City) contracts for the operation of CityLink as the City's public transit service; and

WHEREAS, the City receives grant funding through Federal Transportation Administration (FTA), as authorized by the Congress of the United States of America and Texas Department of Transportation (TXDOT) operating costs; and

WHEREAS, CityLink has a need to replace the scheduling software used for its Paratransit Service; and

WHEREAS, CityLink received a quote from Ecolane through the NCPA for \$103,796.10 for the purchase and first year licensing with an annual fee for years two through five of \$19,398.00; and


WHEREAS, CityLink has funding from its CARES Grant to fund the purchase and funds are budgeted annually for the annual licensing fees.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

- Part 1. That the City Manager is authorized to approve the purchase of the Ecolane software and Year 1 licensing fee through the National Cooperative Purchasing Alliance for \$103,796.10, and an annual fee of \$19,398.00 for years 2-5.
- Part 2. That this resolution is effective immediately.
