

**RESOLUTION NO. 80-2021**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AWARDING THE BID TO UDELHOVEN OILFIELD SYSTEM SERVICES, INC. FOR THE LAKE FORT PHANTOM PUMP STATION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Abilene (City) owns and operates a Public Water Supply System that includes the Lake Fort Phantom Hill water supply and the Lake Fort Phantom Intake Pump Station (Pump Station); and

**WHEREAS**, there are four vertical turbine pumps within the Pump Station and two of those pumps are operated by Variable Frequency Drive (VFD) units located in an adjacent building on the Pump Station site; and

**WHEREAS**, the VFD units are over 20 years old and the replacement parts are no longer available; and

**WHEREAS**, Jacob and Martin, LLC (JM) was hired to provide plans and contract documents, bidding assistance, general project supervision, and contract administration for the needed improvements to the Pump Station; and

**WHEREAS**, Udelhoven Oilfield System Services, Inc. (Udelhoven) submitted the lowest priced qualifying bid in the amount of \$2,049,955.00, and JM has evaluated the bids for best value criteria and for conformity with the advertisement for bids and does recommend awarding the bid to Udelhoven in the amount of \$2,049,955.00; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:**

That the City Manager is authorized to execute a construction contract with Udelhoven Oilfield System Services, Inc. for the Lake Fort Phantom Pump Station Improvements Project in the amount of \$2,049,955.00.
