

**RESOLUTION NO. 85-2021**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS  
APPROVING THE LAND USE PLAN FOR ABILENE REGIONAL AIRPORT**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Abilene (City) owns and operates Abilene Regional Airport; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council approved Resolution 172-2018 contracting with Coffman Associates to create a Land Use Plan for Abilene Regional Airport; and

**WHEREAS**, the focus of the plan has been to identify areas of airport land for commercial/industrial development; and

**WHEREAS**, Coffman and its sub-consultants received input from Airport Staff, the Airport Development Board, Airport Tenants, the city's Planning and Development Staff, and DCOA and AIF Staffs to create a comprehensive plan to develop the areas identified; and

**WHEREAS**, the overriding vision was to create areas that were available for aerospace and non-aerospace companies to locate and that has the infrastructure, aesthetics and amenities to attract world-class companies and bring new high wage jobs to the Abilene community.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:**

- I. That City Council approves this Airport Land Use Plan, which may be used to guide future development projects and market the areas for commercial use.
- II. That this action is effective immediately upon Council approval.
