

RESOLUTION NO. 96-2021

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH ENPROTEC/HIBBS & TODD, INC. FOR THE HAMBY PHASE II MBR EXPANSION.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (Abilene) owns and operates the Hamby Water Reclamation Facility (HWRF) for the treatment of the municipal sewage generated by Abilene and its contracted customers; and

WHEREAS, on June 13, 2019 the Abilene City Council approved a professional services contract with EHT in the amount of \$281,000.00 for engineering services related to the Hamby Phase II MBR Expansion project for the expansion of the Membrane Biological Reactors (MBR) at the Hamby Water Reclamation Facility; and

WHEREAS, During the process of designing the Phase II expansion City staff identified additional items which were not a part of the original scope of services of EHT but were determined to be of sufficient need to incorporate into the Phase II project design; and

WHEREAS, the Amendment No. 1 provides for additional engineering tasks including expanding the existing electrical generator service to maintain baseline process capability, and various improvements throughout the facility; and

WHEREAS, the Amendment No. 1 to the professional services contract with Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd, Inc. will provide for additional design tasks for the Hamby Phase II MBR Expansion in the amount not to exceed \$49,500.00; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the City Manager is authorized to execute the Amendment No. 1 to the professional services contract with Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd, Inc. for the Hamby Phase II MBR Expansion in the amount not to exceed \$49,500.00.
