

**RESOLUTION NO. 108-2021**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS,  
ADOPTING THE 2020 WATER TREATMENT PLANTS MASTER PLAN.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Abilene (Abilene) owns and operates a Public Water System that includes raw water production and water treatment plant facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, Abilene's three water treatment facilities vary greatly in age, and each utilizes unique treatment processes and technologies to produce high quality drinking water, and each has items that require varying degrees of rehabilitation or replacement in order to meet future water demands and compliance criteria; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Abilene contracted with the Plummer engineering firm, assisted by Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd, Inc., for the Water Treatment Plant Master Plan project to evaluate the condition of the existing water treatment facilities and processes, to evaluate water production capacity needs, to assess local water quality preferences and regulatory compliance criteria, and recommend needed capital improvements with schedules and costs; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2020 Water Treatment Plants Master Plan is the culmination of the extensive efforts by City staff and the engineering teams; and

**WHEREAS**, the adoption of the 2020 Water Treatment Plants Master Plan formalizes this master plan as an important tool and reference document to be utilized by City staff when evaluating and planning infrastructure improvements for the City of Abilene's water treatment facilities; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:**

That the Abilene City Council does adopt the 2020 Water Treatment Plants Master Plan as a primary reference resource when evaluating and planning infrastructure improvements to Abilene's water treatment facilities.
