

RESOLUTION NO. 117-2021

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH ENPROTEC/HIBBS & TODD, INC. FOR THE BUTTONWILLOW SEWER INTERCEPTOR REPLACEMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (Abilene) owns and operates a Public Owned Treatment Works that includes the Hamby Water Reclamation Facility and the Wastewater Collection System; and

WHEREAS, the 2010 and 2020 Wastewater Master Plans have identified the need for the rehabilitation and upsizing of the Buttonwillow Sewer Interceptor due to age, piping material, and insufficient wet weather flow capacity; and

WHEREAS, in 2019 Abilene contracted with CSI Consolidated (dba AIMS Companies) for the cleaning and inspection of about twenty thousand linear feet of the Buttonwillow Sewer Interceptor, and that inspection revealed that two piping sections of that project were in very poor condition and in need of immediate rehabilitation or replacement; and

WHEREAS, a point repair was immediately implemented to address one piping section, while the other five thousand foot long section will require a professional engineer to prepare design plans and specifications for a piping replacement project; and


WHEREAS, the professional services contract with Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd, Inc. will provide for the preparation of plans and contract documents, bidding assistance, general project supervision (not RPR) and contract administration in the amount not to exceed \$80,000.00; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the City Manager is authorized to execute the professional services contract with Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd, Inc. for the Buttonwillow Sewer Interceptor Replacement in the lump sum amount of \$80,000.00.
