

RESOLUTION NO. 126-2021

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS
AUTHORIZING THE GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE 2021 JUSTICE ASSISTANCE
GRANT**

WHEREAS, the Abilene Police Department and the Taylor County Sheriff's Office are jointly applying for the 2021 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG Grant) in the amount of \$45,036.00; and

WHEREAS, the City and County agree it is in their best interest to equally split the 2021 JAG grant if awarded, thus giving each entity \$22,518.00; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires City Council approval of the grant and the application thereof; and

WHEREAS, there are no matching fund requirements;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF ABILENE, TEXAS:**

PART 1: The City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute any grant documents to secure the 2021 Justice Assistance Grant.

PART 2: The City Council approves the Interlocal Agreement wherein the City of Abilene will equally distribute the JAG grant, if awarded, with the Taylor County Sheriff's Office.

PART 3: This Resolution is effective immediately upon adoption
