

RESOLUTION NO. 162-2021

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AWARD, THE BULK MATERIALS SUPPLY CONTRACTS TO VARIOUS BIDDERS AS LISTED BELOW – FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE IN THE 2021-22 GENERAL OPERATING BUDGET

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene Street Services Division is requesting the City Council award bids, for materials used in the maintenance of street and alley system. The City of Abilene duly advertised and gave such noticed, as required by law, and bids opened on August 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the following table lists the individual materials bid, and the staff recommended bidder and unit price bid:
