

RESOLUTION NO. 165-2021

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A CLEVERSCAN RAPID, AUTOMATED MANHOLE INSPECTION SYSTEM FOR USE BY THE WATER UTILITIES DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (City) owns and operates a Publicly Owned Treatment Works for the collection and treatment of municipal wastewater; and

WHEREAS, the City has 8,090 manholes used to monitor for excessive infiltration and inflow (I&I), maintain wastewater collection system structural integrity, address public safety-related sanitary sewage issues, and implement general wastewater maintenance requirements; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that more than half of these manholes have exceeded their design service life, potentially compromising their ability to fulfill their purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Water Utilities Department currently does not have the ability to perform an industry standard National Association of Sewer Service Companies NASSCO evaluation of its manholes to determine their actual condition; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends purchasing the CleverScan Rapid, Automated Manhole Inspection System through BuyBoard Cooperative Purchasing, which complies with Texas Government Code Section 791.001, at the contract price of \$73,127.00; and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the City Manager is authorized to execute the documentation necessary to purchase a CleverScan Rapid, Automated Manhole Inspection System through BuyBoard Cooperative Purchasing at a contract price of \$73,127.00
