A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH JACOB MARTIN FOR ENGINEERING AND SURVEYING SERVICES FOR THE DESIGN OF PARK TRAIL RECONSTRUCTION AND PEDESTRIAN ACCESS IMPROVEMENTS OF EXISTING TRAILS LOCATED AT SEARS, REDBUD, AND NELSON PARKS

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene would like to use the services of Jacob Martin; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved funding for the trails at Sears, Redbud, and Nelson Parks during the 2021-2022 budget; and

WHEREAS, the engineering and surveying services need to be completed for the design of the trails; and

WHEREAS, the City seeks to contract with Jacob Martin for the engineering and surveying service for the design of park trail reconstruction and pedestrian access improvements of existing trails located at Sears, Redbud, and Nelson Parks; and

WHEREAS, Jacob Martin will receive compensation not to exceed \$110,000:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Part 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Jacob Martin for the engineering and surveying service for the design of park trail reconstruction and pedestrian access improvements of existing trails located at Sears, Redbud, and Nelson Parks for, a not to exceed amount of, \$110,000.

Part 2: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after passage.
