RESOLUTION NO. 206-2021

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPROVING THE AWARD OF STOP LOSS INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR THE HEALTH PLAN OF THE CITY OF ABILENE FOR PLAN YEAR 2022.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene maintains a self-insured health plan for the medical and prescription medication claims of its employees, and

WHEREAS, it is common industry practice to insure against the risk of large dollar claims of a self-insured health plan by the purchase of stop loss insurance coverage, and

WHEREAS, the current stop loss coverage will expire on December 31, 2021, and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to purchase stop loss coverage for plan year 2022, and

WHEREAS, the City published notices in the Abilene Reporter News for sealed proposals under RFP #CB-2207 Stop Loss Insurance on October 3, 2021 and October 10, 2021, and proposals were due on October 29, 2021, and

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene, through its benefits consultants, McGriff, Seibels & Williams, Inc., received and evaluated the proposals received for said coverage, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the stop loss insurance coverage proposal most advantageous to the City was provided by Blue Cross Blue Shield.

PART 2: That the City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute documents with Blue Cross Blue Shield in order to secure stop loss insurance coverage for plan year 2022.
