

RESOLUTION NO. 07-2022

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AWARDING THE BID TO SOAP ENGINEERING, LLC FOR THE NORTHEAST WATER TREATMENT PLANT SCADA IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, The City of Abilene (City) owns and operates the Northeast Water Treatment Plant (NWTP) for the production of potable water; and

WHEREAS, the NWTP utilizes a Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) system for collecting process data, making automatic flow and process adjustments, and allowing plant operators to observe plant status and control system processes; and

WHEREAS, the existing SCADA system equipment is antiquated and the programming language obsolete making system maintenance, repairs, and updates very difficult; and

WHEREAS, Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd, Inc. (EHT) was hired to evaluate the NWTP SCADA system needs and provide plans and contract documents, bidding assistance, general project supervision (not RPR services), and contract administration for the Northeast Water Treatment Plant SCADA Improvements project; and


WHEREAS, SOAP Engineering, LLC (SOAP) submitted the lowest priced qualifying bid in the amount of \$776,584.00, and EHT has evaluated the bids for best value criteria and for conformity with the advertisement for bids and does recommend awarding the Base Bid and Add Alternate Bid items A1, A2, and A3 to SOAP in the total amount of \$776,584.00; and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the City Manager is authorized to execute a construction contract with SOAP Engineering, LLC for the Northeast Water Treatment Plant SCADA Improvements project in the amount of \$776,584.00.


