

RESOLUTION NO. 13-2022

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH ENPROTEC/HIBBS & TODD, INC. FOR THE DRY POLYMER FEED, SODIUM HYDROXIDE TANKS, AND GRIMES EVALUATION.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (Abilene) owns and operates a Public Water Supply System that includes the Grimes Water Treatment Plant (GWTP), Northeast Water Treatment Plant (NWTP), and the Hargesheimer Water Treatment Plant (HWTP); and

WHEREAS, City staff has identified the need to install new Dry Polymer Feed Systems at the GWTP and the NWTP in order to improve system reliability; and

WHEREAS, City staff has identified the need to increase the bulk storage capacity of Sodium Hydroxide solution at the GWTP, NWTP, and HWTP; and

WHEREAS, City staff has identified the need to evaluate the remaining life of systems and processes along with potential improvement projects for the GWTP in order to sustain capacity and water quality until the GWTP is decommissioned per the WTP Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd, Inc. (EHT) has highly qualified engineers to design the improvements and to conduct the operations round table review of the GWTP; and


WHEREAS, the professional services contract with Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd, Inc. will provide for the preparation of plans and contract documents, bidding assistance, general project supervision (not RPR) and contract administration for the Dry Polymer Feed and Sodium Hydroxide Tanks, and to conduct an Operations Round Table Review of the GWTP in the contract amount of \$101,710.00; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:


That the City Manager is authorized to execute the professional services contract with Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd, Inc. for the Dry Polymer Feed, Sodium Hydroxide Tanks, and Grimes Evaluation in the amount of \$101,710.00.
