RESOLUTION NO. 16-2022

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO BODY-WORN/IN-CAR CAMERA AND REAL TIME INFORMATION CENTER CONTRACT WITH MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS.

WHEREAS, the current technology used by the Abilene Police Department has been in use for over 5 years; and

WHEREAS, the current technology includes body-worn cameras, in-car cameras, interview room cameras, physical servers, and a digital video management system (DVMS); and

WHEREAS, the current support for the body-worn camera equipment is beyond is life cycle and replacement parts are no longer available, and the current DVMS does not support cloud based transfers of video files, and no existing camera system allows for live streaming or in car upleading of video files; and

WHEREAS, the Abilene Police Department does not currently have access to camera views needed for real time information and has existing camera feeds within the city of Abilene available for use with specific software; and

WHEREAS, after review of several vendors who provide needed software and hardware technology, the product provided by Motorola Solutions offers significant improvements to our current systems and furthers the Abilene Police Department in the formation of a Real Time Information Center.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS:

PART 1. That the City Manager is authorized to execute all necessary documents to enter into a Body-Worn/In ar Camera and Real Time Information Center contract with Motorola Solutions.

PART 2. That this Resolution is effective upon adoption.
