

RESOLUTION NO. 24-2022

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AWARDED THE BID TO RANGELINE UTILITY SERVICES, LLC FOR THE IVIE BOOSTER PUMP STATION GROUND STORAGE TANK SILT REMOVAL AND BUTTERFLY VALVE INSTALLATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, The City of Abilene (City) owns and operates the Ivie Pipeline System and the Hargesheimer Water Treatment Plant for the production of potable water; and

WHEREAS, the Ivie Pipeline System includes the Intake Pump Station, Booster Pump Station and 6 MG Ground Storage Tank, and the Ovalo 10 MG Ground Storage Tank; and

WHEREAS, the Booster Ground Storage Tank has a large buildup of silt on the tank bottom that must be removed; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to install a new butterfly valve between the Booster Ground Storage Tank and the Pump Building in order to improve serviceability of the pump station; and

WHEREAS, Jacob and Martin, LLC (JM) was hired to provide plans and contract documents, bidding assistance, general project supervision (not RPR services), and contract administration for the silt removal and butterfly valve installation; and


WHEREAS, Rangeline Utility Services, LLC (Rangeline) submitted the lowest priced qualifying bid in the amount of \$169,189.00, and JM has evaluated the bids for best value criteria and for conformity with the advertisement for bids and does recommend awarding the Base Bid and Additive Alternate Bid item to Rangeline in the total amount of \$169,189.00; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the City Manager is authorized to execute a construction contract with Rangeline Utility Services, LLC for the Ivie Booster Pump Station Ground Storage Tank Silt Removal and Butterfly Valve Installation project in the amount of \$169,189.00.
