

RESOLUTION NO. 25-2022

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING FIRST AMENDMENT TO SERVICES CONTRACT BETWEEN CITY OF ABILENE AND SMITH PUMP COMPANY FOR THE REPAIR OF IVIE INTAKE PUMP #1.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (City) owns and operates the Ivie Pipeline System which includes the Intake Pump Station, Booster Pump Station, the Ovalo Terminal Storage Tank, the transmission pipeline, and an electrical transmission system; and

WHEREAS, the Ivie Intake Pump Station includes three vertical turbine pumps to transfer raw lake water through the pipeline system to the Hargesheimer Water Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, Ivie Intake Pump #1 was inoperable and in need of repairs and City staff was able to secure its repair through a contract with Smith Pump Company, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the removal and disassembly of Pump #1 by the Contractor revealed worn and slightly bent shafts and misaligned column pipe that must be replaced and repaired, respectively, and for which repairs are not included in the original contract scope of work

WHEREAS, staff recommends authorizing First Amendment to Service Contract with Smith Pump Company for additional work including the replacement of eleven shaft segments and repair of column pipe in the amount of \$81,650.00, resulting in the revised contract price of \$196,450.00; and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the City Manager is authorized to execute First Amendment to Services Contract Between City of Abilene and Smith Pump Company for the additional repairs to Ivie Intake Pump #1 in the amount of \$81,650.00, resulting in the revised contract price of \$196,450.00.
