

**RESOLUTION NO 55-2022**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE CITY OF ABILENE TO PARTICIPATE WITHIN THE BRIDGE REPLACEMENT OF THE ES 7<sup>th</sup> STREET BRIDGE AT CEDAR CREEK THROUGH THE FEDERAL OFF-SYSTEM BRIDGE PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.**

WHEREAS, the federal off-system bridge program is administered by the Texas Department of Transportation (the State) to replace or rehabilitate structurally deficient and functionally obsolete (collectively referred to as deficient) bridges located on public roads and streets off the designated state highway system; and

WHEREAS, City of Abilene, hereinafter referred to as the Local Government owns a bridge located at East South 7<sup>th</sup> Street at Cedar Creek, National Bridge Inventory (NBI) Structure Number 082210B21429001, State Control-Section-Job (CSJ) Number 0908-33-106; and

WHEREAS, a project to remedy the bridge is included in the currently approved program of projects as authorized by Texas Transportation Commission Minute Order Number 116073. Dated August 21, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the usual fund participation ratio for projects on such program is 80 percent federal, 10 percent state and 10 percent Local Government, unless reduced by participation in the Economically Disadvantaged County Program; and

WHEREAS, the estimated local match fund participation requirement on the approved federal off-system bridge project is \$158,834.00.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:**


**PART 1:** That the City of Abilene confirms its agreement with the State to secure all match funding for the approved federal off-system bridge project, that all requirements of TAC 43 will be implemented, and the City Manager, in consideration of the foregoing premises and the mutual benefits to be derived therefrom, is hereby authorized and directed to execute and attest on behalf of the City of Abilene, and agreement to Contribute Funds for the above referenced project, referenced by the date of April 14, 2022.

**PART 2:** That the sum of One Hundred-Fifty-Eight Thousand-Eight Hundred-Thirty-Four Dollars and Zero Cents (\$158,834.00), which represents ten percent (10%) of, the estimated total cost of the bridge project, is hereby appropriated and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to pay the sum indicated from the funds available in the budget accounts.
