**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO CONTINUE THE PURCHASE OF LIBRARY MATERIALS FROM BAKER & TAYLOR THROUGH THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE STATE CO-OP PROGRAM CMBL/HUB FOR LIBRARY MATERIALS.**

**WHEREAS**, The City of Abilene is a participate in the State of Texas CO-OP program as outlined by the State Comptroller of Public Accounts; and

**WHEREAS**, Baker & Taylor is on the State of Texas Centralized Master Bidders List/Historically Underutilized Business (CMBL/HUB) vendor list; and

**WHEREAS**, The Abilene Public Library purchases many formats of materials including print, movies, music on DVD, Blu-ray, CD and digital downloadable eBooks, and audiobooks; and

**WHEREAS**, The State of Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts CO-OP meets our competitive bidding requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, The Abilene Public Library budgets for all forms of materials approved by City Council each year.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:**


Part 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to continue the purchases of library materials from Baker & Taylor.
