

RESOLUTION NO. 95-2022

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS ACCEPTING DEAAG FUNDS FOR THE DYESS AIR FORCE IMPROVED AND EXPANDED FIBER AND 5-G INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS OR AGREEMENTS NECESSARY

WHEREAS, on January 27, 2022, the City of Abilene was awarded a Defense Economic Adjustment Assistance Grant (DEAAG) from the Office of the Governor, Texas Military Preparedness Commission; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the DEAAG is to provide state funds to defense communities that have been or may be affected by a base realignment and closure action for the purchase of property, sharing the costs of infrastructure or redevelopment projects, and the purchase or lease of equipment; and

WHEREAS, this DEAAG is in the amount of \$375,000.00, and is for the Improved and Expanded Fiber and 5-G Infrastructure at Dyess Air Force Base; and

WHEREAS, the DEAAG will reimburse the City of Abilene for actual and allowable allocable costs paid; and

WHEREAS, the project will provide increased network resource resiliency for base networks, and the project will enhance or enable more redundancy for non-critical areas; and

WHEREAS, Staff requests approval of a Resolution by City Council accepting the DEAAG, and to authorize the City Manager to execute any necessary documents or agreements for the purposes of the DEAAG and the Improved and Expanded Fiber and 5-G Infrastructure at Dyess Air Force Base.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Part 1: That the City Council of the City of Abilene Accepts the award of the DEAAG for the Improved and Expanded Fiber and 5-G Infrastructure in an amount not to exceed \$375,000.00 and in accordance to the terms and conditions of the January 27, 2022 Defense Economic Adjustment Assistance Grant from the Office of the Governor, Texas Military Preparedness Commission.

Part 2: That the City Manager is authorized to execute any necessary documents or agreements for the purposes of the DEAAG grant and associated project.


Part 3: That the City Council finds that the use of the DEAAG funds for the reimbursement to Dyess Air Force Base of actual and allowable allocable costs paid for the construction of the Improved and Expanded Fiber and 5-G Infrastructure will serve a predominately public purpose, and the city will retain sufficient control to ensure the public purpose is carried out, and the city will receive a benefit.

Part 4. That this Resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
