

**RESOLUTION NO. 105-2022**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS,  
AWARDING THE BID TO BLACKROCK CONSTRUCTION FOR THE E.N. 10<sup>TH</sup> AND  
S. MAPLE STREET UTILITY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Abilene (City) owns and operates a Public Water Supply System and a permitted Wastewater Treatment Plant and Collection Facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is preparing design plans for the rehabilitation of paved roadway surfaces along E.N. 10<sup>th</sup> Street and along S. Maple Street, and there are existing water distribution and wastewater collection facilities within the rights-of-way of those street sections which need upgrading and/or relocation prior to the roadway rehabilitation; and

**WHEREAS**, Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd, Inc. (EHT) was hired to provide plans and contract documents, bidding assistance, general project supervision, and contract administration for the needed improvements for the utility improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, Blackrock Construction (BRC) submitted the lowest priced qualifying bid in the amount of \$2,480,075.00, and EHT has evaluated the bids for best value criteria and for conformity with the advertisement for bids and does recommend awarding the bid to BRC in the amount of \$2,480,075.00; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:**

That the City Manager is authorized to execute a construction contract with Blackrock Construction for the E.N. 10<sup>th</sup> and S. Maple Street Utility Improvements in the amount of \$2,480,075.00.
