

**RESOLUTION NO. 106-2022**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AWARDING THE REBID FOR THE PURCHASE OF BULK CHLORINE CHEMICAL USED BY WATER TREATMENT PLANTS IN FISCAL YEAR 2022.**

**WHEREAS**, on September 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2021 the Abilene City Council awarded the bid for various bulk chemicals used for water and wastewater treatment processes during fiscal year 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, due to unforeseeable economic conditions affecting the cost of producing Chlorine, the originally awarded vendor for CB-2144 is not able to continue to supply Chlorine at the then awarded bid price thus requiring City staff to initiate a rebidding process for bulk Chlorine; and

**WHEREAS**, the originally awarded vendor DPC Industries, Inc. submitted the sole rebid unit price for bulk Chlorine as described below:

The rebid of Chlorine resulted in a cost increase of about \$97,350.00 above the originally budgeted annual cost for Chlorine; and

**WHEREAS**, City staff, after evaluating the bid submittal for fiscal year 2022, does recommend awarding the bid to the low bidder identified herein; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:**

The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with DPC Industries, Inc. in the amount of the above listed unit price for the remainder of fiscal year 2022.
