

RESOLUTION NO. 119-2022

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH ACE PIPE CLEANING, INC. THROUGH PURCHASING COOPERATIVE OF AMERICA FOR THE CLEANING AND INSPECTION OF THE WEST SEWER INTERCEPTOR PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene owns and operates a permitted publicly owned treatment works that includes the Hamby Water Reclamation Facility and the wastewater collection system; and

WHEREAS, City staff developed and implemented a large sewer main cleaning and inspection program, which is a provision of the Sanitary Sewer Overflow Initiative Agreement with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, and several sewer mains have been identified and prioritized for cleaning and inspection; and

WHEREAS, cleaning and inspecting the west sewer interceptor is of high priority in order to maximize the capacity of the piping to accommodate current and potential future customer discharges, and to assess the condition of the piping for prioritizing future improvements; and

WHEREAS, it was determined that the City could obtain the cleaning and inspection services through Purchasing Cooperative of America (PCA) at contract pricing in compliance with Texas Local Government Code Chapter 271, and said pricing is a good value for the City; and


WHEREAS, City staff recommends the contract with Ace Pipe Cleaning, Inc. for the Cleaning and Inspection of the West Sewer Interceptor Project in the amount of \$159,275.51; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the Abilene City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute the contract with Ace Pipe Cleaning, Inc. for the West Sewer Interceptor Cleaning and Inspection Project in the amount of \$159,275.51.


