

**RESOLUTION NO. 133-2022**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ACCEPTANCE OF THE FY 22 AIRPORT IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM GRANT OFFERED BY THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION.**

**WHEREAS,** The City of Abilene (City) owns and operates Abilene Regional Airport; and

**WHEREAS,** Abilene Regional Airport participates in the Airport Improvement Program through the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), as authorized by the Congress of the United States of America;

**WHEREAS,** the Airport Improvement Program is funded nationally through taxes and fees charged by the FAA on airline tickets and aviation fuel sales; and

**WHEREAS,** Abilene Regional Airport has demonstrated to FAA the need for Fiscal Year 2022 grant funding to make improvements to the airport terminal, purchase a replacement Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting Truck, and conduct additional coordinated capital planning; and

**WHEREAS,** this grant will pay 90% of eligible costs and the City will provide a 10% match from remaining 2015 General Obligation Bond Proposition 9 funds; and


**WHEREAS,** FAA offers to the City of Abilene the FY 22 Airport Improvement Program Grant in the amount not to exceed \$1,110,855.00.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:**

That the City Manager is authorized to execute the FY22 Airport Improvement Program Grant Offer not to exceed \$1,110,855.00 from FAA, which requires a 10% local match, for improvements at Abilene Regional Airport.
