

RESOLUTION NO. 134-2022

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ACCEPTANCE OF THE FY22 AIRPORT INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT OFFERED BY THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION.

WHEREAS, The City of Abilene (City) owns and operates Abilene Regional Airport; and

WHEREAS, Abilene Regional Airport participates in the Airport Improvement Program through the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), as authorized by the Congress of the United States of America;

WHEREAS, Under the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law, Congress directed FAA to distribute five annual grants to airports to address capital project needs unmet in the Airport Improvement Program (AIP) through a new program called the Airport Infrastructure Grant (AIG); and

WHEREAS, Abilene Regional Airport has demonstrated to FAA the need for Fiscal Year 2022 grant funding to make improvements to the airport terminal, and conduct additional coordinated capital planning; and

WHEREAS, The FY22 Airport Infrastructure Grant will pay 90% of eligible costs and the City will provide a 10% match from remaining 2015 General Obligation Bond Proposition 9 funds; and


WHEREAS, FAA offers to the City of Abilene a FY22 Airport Infrastructure Grant in the amount not to exceed \$1,163,905.00.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the City Manager is authorized to execute the FY22 Airport Infrastructure Grant Offer not to exceed \$1,163,905.00 from FAA, which requires a 10% local match, for improvements at Abilene Regional Airport.
