

RESOLUTION NO. 142-2022

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AWARDED THE BID TO REDI-PAK FOR THE BUCK CREEK CAT ENGINE REBUILD.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (City) owns and operates the Hamby Water Reclamation Facility, the wastewater collection system, and the Buck Creek Pump Station Facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Buck Creek Pump Station consists of four large pumping units to pump Abilene's municipal wastewater through a large force main to the Hamby Water Reclamation Facility; and

WHEREAS, three of the Buck Creek pumps are electrically powered, but Pump No. 4 is powered by a Caterpillar (CAT) brand natural gas-fueled engine which is wearing out, consuming large quantities of lubricating oil, and in need of a rebuild; and


WHEREAS, the City advertised for bids for rebuilding the CAT engine, and Redi-Pak submitted the sole bid for the turn-key rebuild of the CAT engine, and City staff has evaluated the bid for compliance with the scope of work and does recommend awarding the bid to Redi-Pak in the amount of \$86,539.73; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:


That the City Manager is authorized to execute the contract with Redi-Pak for the Buck Creek Cat Engine Rebuild in the amount of \$86,539.73.
