

RESOLUTION NO. 159-2022

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AWARDED THE BID TO DOWTECH SPECIALTY CONTRACTORS, INC. FOR THE HAMBY WATER RECLAMATION FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS PHASE II EXPANSION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (Abilene) owns and operates the Hamby Water Reclamation Facility (HWRF) for the treatment of the municipal sewage generated by Abilene and its contracted customers; and

WHEREAS, the HWRF underwent a major renovation completed in late 2015 including the installation of a Membrane BioReactor (MBR) filtration system to produce high quality treated effluent as feedwater for a new Indirect Potable Reuse Program; and

WHEREAS, in 2019 the Hamby Water Reclamation Facility Improvements Phase I project added additional MBR cassettes into the remaining open slots of the MBR system; and

WHEREAS, Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd Inc. was hired to provide plans and specifications, bidding assistance, general project supervision, and contract administration for constructing certain improvements and the installation of additional MBR equipment in the two-remaining future-expansion cells constructed as part of the plant renovation; and


WHEREAS, Dowtech Specialty Contractors, Inc. (Dowtech) submitted the second lowest priced bid, and based on the "best value" selection process, the Engineer and City staff recommend awarding the Hamby Water Reclamation Facility Improvements Phase II Expansion Project to Dowtech in the amount of \$6,830,870.00; and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the City Manager is authorized to execute the Contract with Dowtech Specialty Contractors Inc. for the Hamby Water Reclamation Facility Improvements Phase II Expansion in the amount of \$6,830,870.00.
