

RESOLUTION NO. 160-2022

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AWARDING THE BID TO RANGELINE UTILITY SERVICES, LLC FOR THE 30" BUTTERFLY VALVE REPLACEMENT-GRIMES BOOSTER PUMP STATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (Abilene) owns and operates the north raw water pipeline system consisting of the Lake Fort Phantom Hill Intake Pump Station and parallel pipelines extending south to the Grimes Water Treatment Plant and including a connection to the Hubbard Pipeline System, the Raw Water Disinfection Facility, and the branch line supplying the Northeast Water Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, the parallel pipelines and appurtenances are aged and certain inline valves have become inoperable and in need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, staff is implementing a program to systematically replace the valves along the parallel pipelines prioritizing replacements based on known valve condition and importance to operations; and

WHEREAS, the 30" valve scheduled for replacement has failed internal parts that are inaccessible, and the valve is of high importance for isolating pipelines for making repairs; and


WHEREAS, Rangeline Utility Services LLC (Rangeline) submitted the lowest priced bid, and based on the "best value" selection process City staff recommends awarding the 30" Butterfly Valve Replacement-Grimes Booster Pump Station Project to Rangeline in the amount of \$160,823.00; and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the City Manager is authorized to execute the Contract with Rangeline Utility Services LLC for the 30" Butterfly Valve Replacement-Grimes Booster Pump Station in the amount of \$160,823.00.
