

RESOLUTION NO. 176-2022

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE WORK ORDERS ASSOCIATED WITH INSTALLING THE SAFETY AND SECURITY CAMERAS AND ACCESS CONTROLS AT VARIOUS CITY FACILITIES WITH SIGMA SURVEILLANCE INCORPORATED.

WHEREAS, The City has standardized on cost-effective and efficient safety and security solutions, including access control systems that minimize resource and maintenance costs over five years; and

WHEREAS, Since June 2020, the City has compared, tested and installed the systems in the Departments of Information Technology, Community Services, Health, Zoo, City Hall, Minter Park, the Armory, Everman Park, Everman Park Tunnels, Water Department, Convention Center, and Police Impound Lot.; and

WHEREAS, purchases are made utilizing the Texas Department of Information Resources (DIR) and/or BuyBoard Contract pricing for government and include a ten (10) year warranty on cameras with five (5) year licenses, wiring and installation; and

WHEREAS, work orders to be executed include the Animal Services (\$57,290.29), South Branch Library (\$68,653.07), North Branch Library (\$63,088.32), Mercy Clinic (\$71,088.14), Health (\$30,805.13), and City Hall (\$95,802.88). The total of these work orders is \$386,727.83, including all wiring and installation services..

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:


