

RESOLUTION NO. 186-2022

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE
ABILENE-TAYLOR COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH DISTRICT AND PATAGONIA
HEALTH**

WHEREAS, the Abilene-Taylor County Public Health District requires an electronic system to record and store medical records and health information; and

WHEREAS, the current electronic health record (EHR) system does not provide critical functions to improve workflow, billing and data transfer to the state database; and

WHEREAS, the City conducted a Request for Proposal (RFP) process to advertise the need for an electronic health record system; and

WHEREAS, each vendor was evaluated for minimum criteria and functionality useful to the unique needs of public health; and

WHEREAS, Patagonia Health specializes in providing EHR systems to public health departments; and

WHEREAS, Patagonia Health will be able to transfer immunization data directly into the state's ImmTrac2 database, and

WHEREAS, Patagonia Health provides a robust reporting module that builds reports based on state reporting requirements and an electronic billing module; and

WHEREAS, the ATCPHD solicited demos and bids from other EHR vendors and determined that Patagonia Health would best meet the unique needs of public health at the best cost value.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
ABILENE, TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS:**


