

**RESOLUTION NO. 190-2022**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AWARDING THE BID TO PURCELL CONTRACTING LLC FOR THE SECOND PRESSURE PLANE SUPPLY PHASE 3-PROPOSED NORTHWEST PUMP STATION PROJECT.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Abilene (City) owns and operates a Public Water Supply System that includes three water treatment plants and the water distribution system; and

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has issued a Notice of Violation due to the low pressure conditions existing upstream of the existing High Level Pump Station and for which cannot be reasonably resolved by modifying the pump station and thus requiring major infrastructure improvements in west Abilene to resolve that issue; and

**WHEREAS**, Jacob and Martin, LLC (JM) was hired to provide plans and contract documents, bidding assistance, general project supervision, and contract administration for the needed improvements for the Second Pressure Plane Pump Station-Phase 3; and

**WHEREAS**, Purcell Contracting, LLC (Purcell) submitted the lowest priced qualifying bid in the amount of \$8,391,850.00, and JM has evaluated the bids for best value criteria and for conformity with the advertisement for bids and does recommend awarding the bid to Purcell in the amount of \$8,391,850.00; and


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:**


That the City Manager is authorized to execute a construction contract with Purcell Contracting, LLC for the Second Pressure Plane Supply Phase 3-Proposed Northwest Pump Station in the amount of \$8,391,850.00.
