

RESOLUTION NO. 31-2023

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS APPROVING THE 2023 OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR SOLICITATION PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE FY 2024 RIFLE RESISTANT BODY ARMOR GRANT.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene, Abilene Police Department, finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Abilene, Texas to apply for the 2023 Office of the Governor Solicitation Public Safety Office FY 2024 Rifle Resistant Body Armor Grant; and

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the Grant application; and

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the City of Abilene assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full; and

WHEREAS, the City Council designates Deputy City Manager, Mindy Patterson, as the Grantee's authorized official, and the authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the Grant on behalf of the City of Abilene, Abilene Police Department.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:


PART 1: The City Council approves submission and acceptance of the grant application for the 2023 Office of the Governor Solicitation Public Safety Office FY 2024 Rifle Resistant Body Armor Grant.
